Sian gave update on Rep Rugby. We intend to enter all three teams in County Championships this coming season. A discussion was had re our readiness to apply to join Division One of the Senior Men's competition. It is likely that we are not there yet. It would require significant additional funding as counties playing in Division One are further from us.

Kit will be ordered at the start of the year, so provider knows our needs. Additional kit will only be purchased with the Director of Finances approval.

Cup Competitions. We do not have provision for a club to have the opportunity to defend a cup they have won in a preceding year. We will amend our competition rules to ensure that this is possible in future seasons.
