Purpose of the Girls Lead Role

The Girl's Lead is responsible for the leadership and management of Age-Grade Girls rugby in Devon. The role works in conjunction with the Director of Age-Grade Rugby to create a comprehensive approach to the overall development, growth and sustainability of the female game in terms of game development and stakeholder management.

The individual will:

- Be the main point of contact for age-grade girls related queries and signposting.
- Lead a small working party who manage the Girl's game. This consists of a Fixture Secretary and a lead for all Cup Competitions
- Consult with the RFU on specific girls' rugby campaigns and initiatives.
- Organise and lead stakeholder engagement events.
- Play an initiative-taking role in assisting not only the leads in the club's network but also the U16s PDG and U18s County Squad to ensure a cohesive and collaborative approach is achieved.

Skills and Qualities for the Role:

- Organised and an excellent communicator
- Knowledgeable of the Girls Game in Devon in terms of the competition framework for all age bands and current infrastructure.
- Experienced in stakeholder management and be able to manage a wide range of personalities with clarity and diplomacy.
- Able to visualise the geographical challenges of clubs and have a broad understanding of need and individual challenges.

- Able to work as a team, acting as the liaison between various levels of leadership within the County.
- Able to communicate and proactively seek relationships with leads in other counties.
- Willing and able to complete annual reviews and manage small budgets on behalf of Devon RFU.
